Moodle's Workshop Activity delta

Key features of the Workshop Activity

Moodle's Workshop activity is similar in some ways to the Assignment module, but it also offers additional features, such as peer assessment (through which students assess other students' work). In a Workshop activity, students submit their work through Moodle; the submission may consist of online text and/or attached files. Each student submits his or her own work, so group assignments are not supported in the Workshop module (in the sense of having one submission per group of students).

Student submissions are assessed using a structured assessment form defined in advance by the instructor. The Workshop activity supports several types of assessment forms, and supports multi-criteria assessments. For peer assessment, students are assigned other students' submissions to assess, and they do so using the assessment form provided by the instructor. The Workshop module coordinates the collection and distribution of these assessments.

Students get two grades in a Workshop activity: a grade for their own submission and another grade for their assessment of others' work. The Workshop activity creates two grade items in the course grade book that can be aggregated further as needed.

The instructor can, if desired, include one or more example submissions that students can assess in practice, to help them understand the assessment form and the process of peer assessment. Example assessments can also be provided for students as references for what is expected from their own assessments.

The instructor can publish selected submissions to the rest of the class, so they are available to other students at the end of the Workshop activity (as opposed to the Assignment module in which submitted work is shared only between a student and the instructor).

Workshop vs. Assignment

Workshop	Assignment
Relatively easy for novice Moodle instructor	
Supports group work: a single grade can be assigned to a group of students	
Supports use of grading rubrics and/or custom assessment forms	
Allows students to assess each others' submissions	
Supports inclusion of examples for students to follow	
Selected student submissions can be published to the whole class

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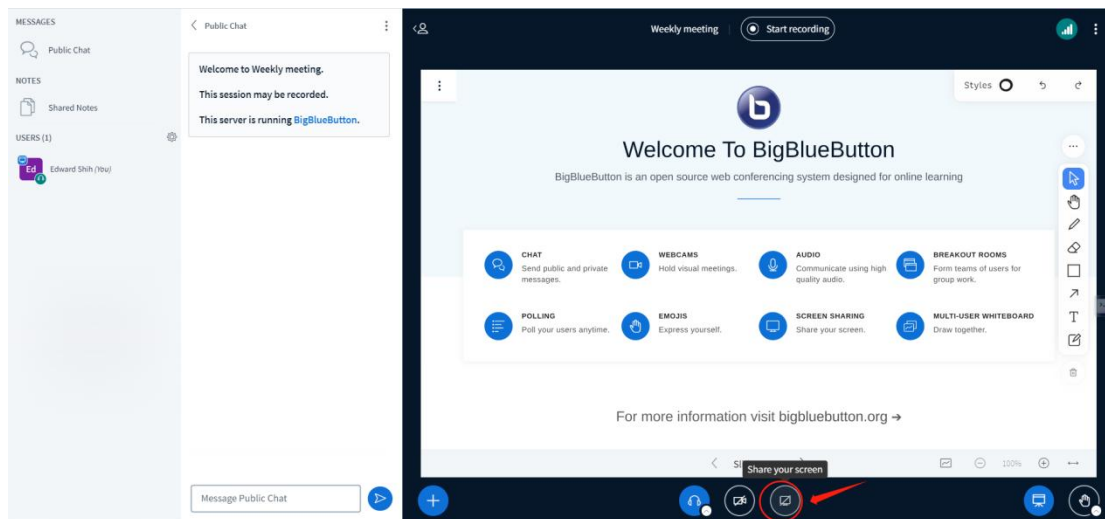
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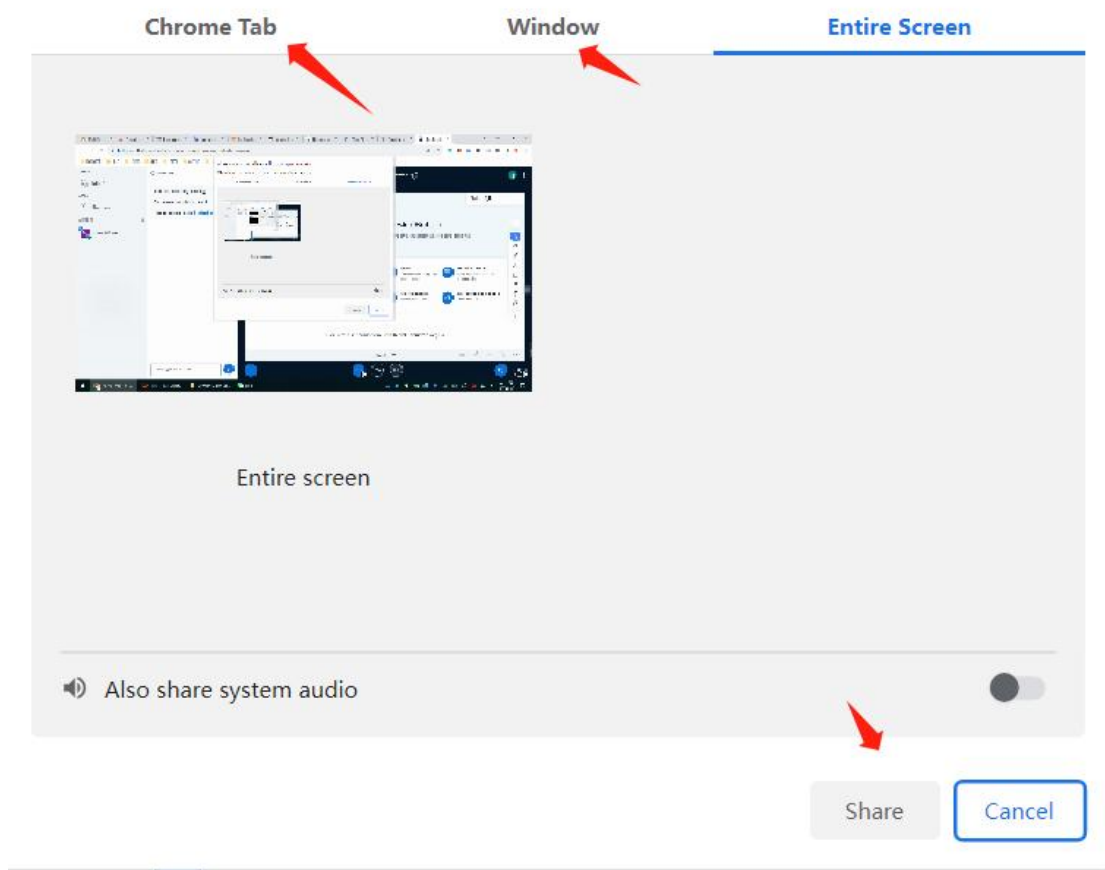
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8. As a teacher, click the “Share your screen” button to share the screen. You can share your browser tab, window or entire screen.

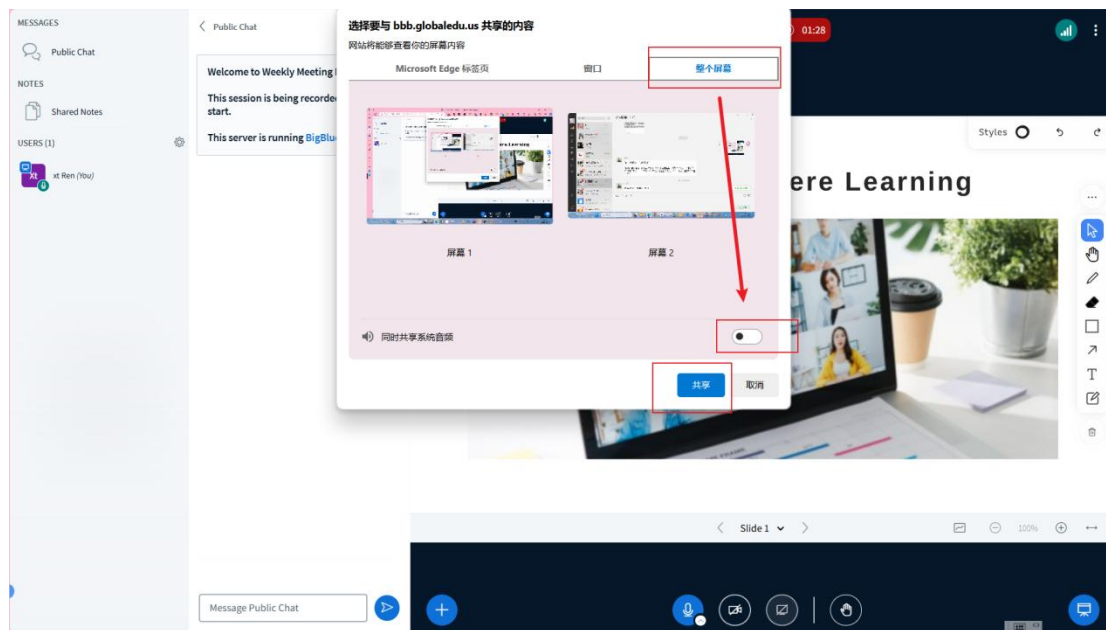

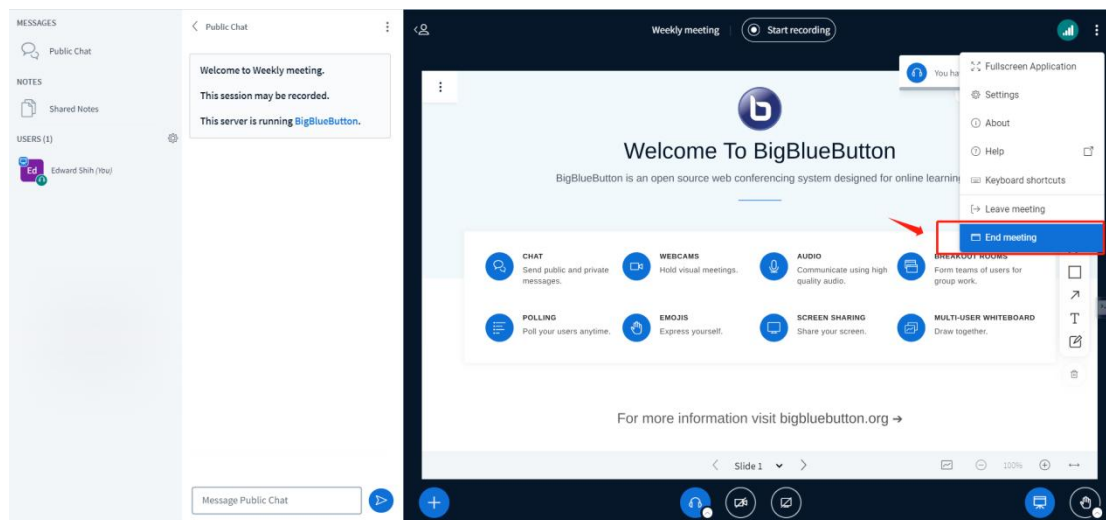
